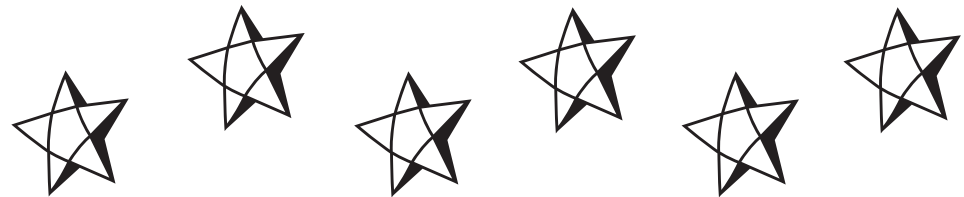

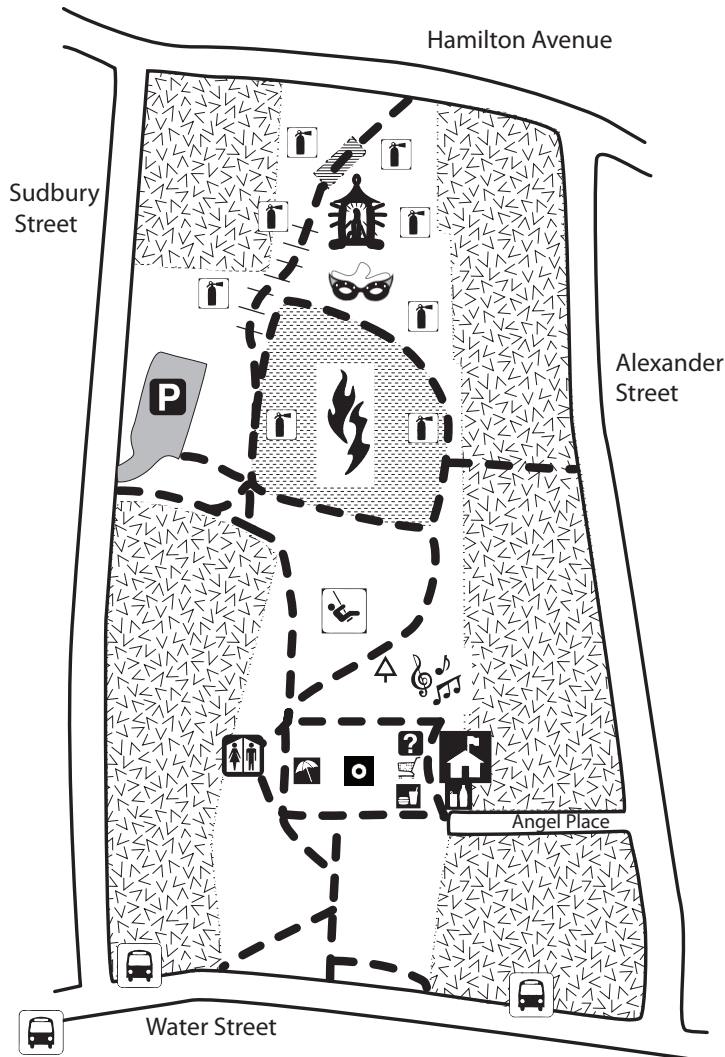

Lantern and Fire Safety

There will be NO unauthorized use of fire or pyrotechnics.

All paper lanterns must be well coated with fire-retarding glue and have 2" clearance around the flame. If a lantern should catch fire, lower it to the ground away from clothing. DO NOT attempt to extinguish by stepping on it: Fire marshals will use fire extinguishers.
